OHIO ATHLETIC COMMISSION

Minutes of the November 14, 2017 meeting of the Ohio Athletic Commission ("OAC") held at 10:00 A.M. at the Bureau of Workers' Compensation, Garfield Heights, Ohio.

- I. The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Director Bernie Profato. Roll call was taken by Mr. Profato. Present for roll call were: Commissioner Armile, Commissioner Mancini, Commissioner Patton, and Commissioner Schuerger.
- II. The minutes of the October 10, 2017 meeting were first on the agenda. Commissioner Patton moved to approve the minutes. Commissioner Mancini seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.
- III. The Licensure list was presented for Commission approval. Commissioner Patton moved to approve the Licensure list. Commissioner Mancini seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.
- IV. Under unfinished business Mr. Profato discussed new developments into the bloodwork investigation and outcome. Mr. Profato will submit a formal letter to the commission. Commissioner Patton moved to approve. Commissioner Mancini seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

A MMA Pro AM event in Bellefontaine on November 22 promoted by Dannon Svab.


Commissioner Patton moved to approve the event. Commissioner Mancini seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.
