**OHIO ATHLETIC COMMISSION**

Minutes of the October 10, 2017 meeting of the Ohio Athletic Commission ("OAC") held at 10:00 A.M. at the Bureau of Workers' Compensation, Garfield Heights, Ohio.

- I. The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Director Bernie Profato. Roll call was taken by Mr. Profato. Present for roll call were: Commissioner Stainbrook, Commissioner Armile and Commissioner Patton.
- II. The minutes of the September 12, 2017 meeting were first on the agenda. Commissioner Armile moved to approve the minutes. Commissioner Patton seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.
- III. The Licensure list was presented for Commission approval. Everyone was approved with the exception of Dominic Bentz. Commissioner Armile moved to approve the Licensure list. Commissioner Patton seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.
- IV. Under unfinished business Mr. Profato discussed the bloodwork investigation. Mr. Profato stated that anyone affiliated with Joe Bridenbaugh should not receive a license until the investigation is completed. After hearing the license review, Dominic Bentz, was granted a temporary promotor's license under the condition no belts will be awarded under this license. This temporary license will stay in effect until the investigation is over. The commission moved to approve this temporary license. Commissioner Patton seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.  
  
Also discussed were the appeal options for Ravone Littlejohn from a suspension letter that was sent out in regards to infractions from a boxing event that was held on June 30 in Toledo. Ravon Littlejohn has until September 30, 2017 to appeal the suspension letter.
- V. New business, State Audit. This audit was the smoothest and quickest audit the commission has ever had.
- VI. A MMA event in Akron on October 21 promoted by Jeremy Caudill. Commissioner Armile moved to approve the event. Commissioner Patton seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

A MMA event in Montpelier on October 28 promoted by Fred Vallejo. Commissioner Armile

moved to approve the event. Commissioner Patton seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

A PRO boxing event in Toledo on November 4 promoted by Victor Green. Commissioner Armile moved to approve the event. Commissioner Patton seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

A PRO boxing event in Cleveland on November 10 promoted by Dibella Entertainment. Commissioner Armile moved to approve the event. Commissioner Patton seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

VII. Executive Director's report:

1) New to the commission is Hollie Musolino-Goodin. Hollie replaced Marilyn Houy. Hollie was the top choice out of 193 applicants. DAS, Bernie Profato and Judy McCarty conducted the structured interviews.

2) The attorney for Dibella Entertainment will be coming to Ohio to discuss having shows in Ohio for 2018.

VIII. There were no public comments.

IX. Commissioner Armile moved to adjourn. Commissioner Patton seconded the motion, and it was unanimously approved.
