OHIO ATHLETIC COMMISSION

Minutes of the September 12, 2017 meeting of the Ohio Athletic Commission ("OAC") held at 10:00 A.M. at the Bureau of Workers' Compensation, Garfield Heights, Ohio.

- I. The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Director Bernie Profato. Roll call was taken by Mr. Profato. Present for roll call were: Commissioner Schuerger, Commissioner Stainbrook, Commissioner Armile and Commissioner Patton. It was noted that Chairman Schuerger was reappointed.
- II. The minutes of the August 8, 2017 meeting were first on the agenda. Commissioner Armile moved to approve the minutes. Commissioner Stainbrook seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

The Licensure list was presented for Commission approval. Commissioner Stainbrook moved to approve the Licensure list. Commissioner Armile seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.
