Minutes of the March 13, 2017 meeting of the Ohio Athletic Commission ("OAC") held at 10:00 A.M. at the Bureau of Workers' Compensation, Garfield Heights, Ohio.

- I. The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Director Bernie Profato. Roll call was taken by Mr. Profato. Present for roll call were: Commissioner Stainbrook, Commissioner Schuerger, Commissioner Armile, Commissioner Patton.
- II. The minutes of the February 13, 2018 meeting were first on the agenda. Commissioner Stainbrook moved to approve the minutes. Commissioner Armile seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.
- III. The Licensure list was presented for Commission approval. Commissioner Stainbrook moved to approve the Licensure list. Commissioner Armile seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.
- IV. Unfinished business: The lawsuit, Atty. Brian Honen. The lawsuit has been dismissed without prejudice by the plaintiff. Without prejudice means the plaintiff has 1 year to refile. Commissioner Stainbrook moved to accept, Commissioner Armile seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Outcome from the Executive Session, a motion for disciplinary action for a 60-day suspension for the Inspector of this event and a 30-day suspension for the referee of this event. Commissioner Stainbrook moved to accept, Commissioner Armile seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

VII. Executive Director Report- Commissioners need to submit their financial report to the commission office. The report is due by Tax Day (April 15). There were approximately 150 licenses sent out March 9, 2018 from the Arnold Classic. 180-day suspension was given for Nate Farley (W. Virginia) from an Akron event being verbally abusive to the Dr. for stopping the event. February revenue is in. Commissioner Stainbrook made mention that there were bout changes in Victor Green's Toledo event. There were only 7 fights due to one fighter not showing up for weigh ins. The fighter will be suspended if there was a contract signed.
