
- I. The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Director Bernie Profato. Roll call was taken by Mr. Profato. Present for roll call were: Commissioner Armile, Commissioner Patton, Commissioner Mancini.
- II. The minutes of the April 10, 2018 meeting were first on the agenda. Commissioner Stainbrook moved to approve the minutes. Commissioner Armile moved to accept, and Commissioner Mancini seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.
